- 6. Repeat rows 3 and 4 until the dishcloth reaches your desired length.
- 7. Cast off all stitches.
- 8. Weave in loose ends using your yarn needle.
- 9. Block the dishcloth to enhance the texture, if desired.

- 6. Row 5: Knit 4, *purl 8, knit 8*. Repeat from * to * until the last 4 stitches, then knit the remaining 4 stitches.
- 7. Row 6: Purl the first 4 stitches, *knit 8, purl 8*. Repeat from * to * until the last 4 stitches, then purl the remaining 4 stitches.
- 8. Repeat rows 5 and 6 six more times.
- 9. Repeat rows 1 to 4 once.
- 10. Cast off all stitches.
- 11. Weave in loose ends using your yarn needle.
- 12. Block the dishcloth to accentuate the basketweave pattern, if desired.
