lively, impressive.

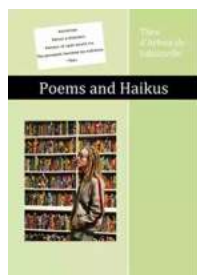

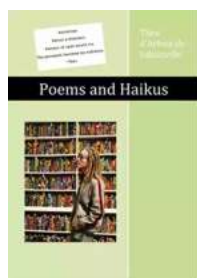
